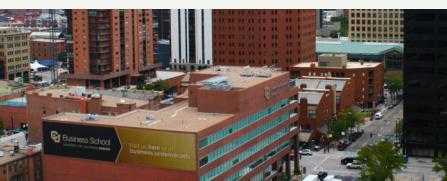
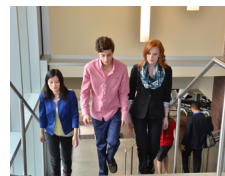
Students must complete three entrepreneurship elective courses and one capstone course from the list below to earn the certificate. Courses are in-person unless otherwise specified with OL for online.
