How To Apply for Graduate Entrepreneurship Certificates

The Jake Jabs Center for Entrepreneurship at the CU Denver Business School offers three graduate-level certificates:

- 1. Entrepreneurship Certificate (3 courses)
- 2. Bioinnovation and Entrepreneurship Certificate (3 courses)
- 3. International Entrepreneurship Badge (4 courses)

All ENTP courses are for credit and are fully transferable should you decide to pursue an MBA or MS degree at the CU Denver Business School.

To apply for the Entrepreneurship Certificate, Bioinnovation and Entrepreneurship Certificate or the International Entrepreneurship Badge you must submit an <u>online application</u>. The application fee is \$50 for domestic (U.S.) students and \$75 for international students. Please follow the directions below:

- 1. When you get to the "Academic Interest" section, Select "Nondegree".
- 2. New drop-down menus will appear. Select **"Business School Non-Degree"** under "Non-Degree".
- 3. Under "Please choose a subplan," select "Business- Graduate Certificate".
- 4. Under "Term you plan to enroll," select the semester for which you wish to start taking classes.
- 5. Select "Continue," finish and submit the application.
- 6. Immediately email <u>bschool.admissions@ucdenver.edu</u> and indicate that you wish to be admitted for the Entrepreneurship Certificate, Bioinnovation and Entrepreneurship Certificate or the International Entrepreneurship Badge.
